

SAVE OUR CAPITOL!

Visitor Center will Destroy the West Side of Our Historic Capitol—Forever!

Even though the visitor center is included in the Capitol Annex project's certified Environmental Impact Report (EIR), the State has not yet approved it, nor has it publicly abandoned its plans to build it.

At an oral argument on *Save Our Capitol!'s* appeal in a CEQA action challenging the Capitol Annex Project, Justice Hull stated:

"We're not dealing with an apartment complex or a shopping center here. We're dealing with the State Capitol.... It doesn't belong to the Legislature or the Executive. It belongs to the people of California."
